6. Cast off all stitches.

To make the handle:

7. Cast on 20 stitches in the main color.
8. Knit 2 rows in the main color.
9. Cast off all stitches.

To assemble:

10. Sew the handle to the top of the tea cosy, leaving a 1cm gap in the center for the spout.
11. Fold the bottom edge of the tea cosy up and sew it in place to create a brim.
12. Weave in any loose ends.

Tips

- For a thicker tea cosy, use worsted weight yarn instead of DK weight yarn.
- To make the tea cosy even more festive, add embellishments such as beads, sequins, or embroidery.
- If you are a beginner knitter, you may want to practice knitting a swatch before starting the tea cosy.

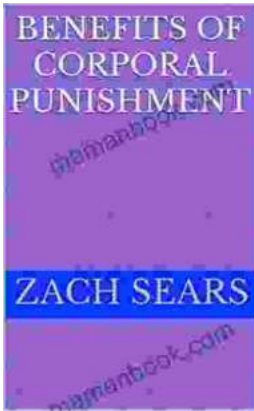
