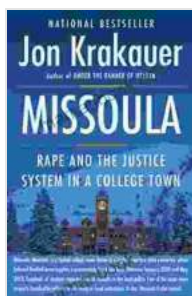


Rape and the Justice System in College Town

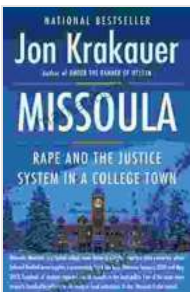

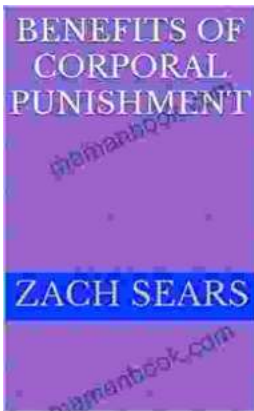
